Ignite Leadership Program

Ignite is a leadership learning path for supervisors, team leaders and coordinators in local government. It will enable those who have limited experience in managing and leading people to develop the competencies required to be successful in their role, while supporting their effective transition to leadership.

The role of a supervisor, team leader or coordinator is as much about leading people as it is about managing the delivery of a service. It is crucial for people in these roles to develop team building and leadership qualities.

The Ignite Leadership Program was designed for Western Australian local government, for people who are new to leadership roles or who wish to further develop their skills. Ignite targets core skills identified as critical for people to thrive in these roles.

Practical sessions and components include:

- Workshops designed to teach, support and motivate participants.
- A one-hour individual coaching session to reinforce good on-the-job habits.
- Scenario practice unique to local government.

Ignite will help you to think about where your career is going and the skills you need to grow.

- Acquire key skills to build and lead teams and encourage their best performance.
- Explore the challenges that face team leaders, supervisors and coordinators in local government.

ONE-ON-ONE COACHING

Coaching encourages the definitive action required to achieve those goals: following through, implementation and accountability in a team environment.

Coaches will:

- Work with participants to set goals and assist them on a pathway to achieving these.
- Help participants to gain clarity and focus for stronger results.
- Provide participants with the tools, support and structure to accomplish more.

PARTICIPANT PROFILE

The program is designed specifically for people working in Western Australian local government, metropolitan and regional.

The typical program participant will be in, or is to be appointed to, an entry-level supervisory, team leader, coordinator or management role and have limited experience or need to extend their skills in managing or leading teams.
